<b>911</b>	911 INCIDENT (TYPE)	Wireline, Wireless, or VoIP: Abandoned, Silent, or Open 911 line where the nature of an emergency incident cannot otherwise be determined.
<b>A1L1</b>	ALERT 1 LEVEL 1	LVIA Alert - Level 1 Fire Response / Level 1 EMS Response
<b>A2</b>	ALERT 2	Reported problem aboard any aircraft inbound to LVIA; Reported by the LVIA tower.
<b>A2L1</b>	ALERT 2 LEVEL 1	LVIA Alert - Level 2 Fire Response / Level 1 EMS Response
<b>A2L2</b>	ALERT 2 LEVEL 2	LVIA Alert - Level 2 Fire Response / Level 2 EMS Response
<b>A2L3</b>	ALERT 2 LEVEL 3	LVIA Alert - Level 2 Fire Response / Level 3 EMS Response
<b>A3</b>	ALERT 3	Aircraft down / crash which occurs at LVIA; Reported by the LVIA tower.
<b>A3L1</b>	ALERT 3 LEVEL 1	LVIA Alert - Level 3 Fire Response / Level 1 EMS Response
<b>A3L2</b>	ALERT 3 LEVEL 2	LVIA Alert - Level 3 Fire Response / Level 2 EMS Response
<b>A3L3</b>	ALERT 3 LEVEL 3	LVIA Alert - Level 3 Fire Response / Level 3 EMS Response
<b>ABDUCT</b>	ABDUCTION / KIDNAP / CARJACK **	The forcible taking of a person / child against their will.
<b>AIR</b>	AIRCRAFT DOWN *	Crash of downing of a civilian or military aircraft.

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<b>ALARMH</b>	HOLD-UP / PANIC ALARM	Commercial or Residential Hold-Up or Panic Alarm. Indicate type in remarks either Hold-Up or Panic or Domestic Violence Alarm.
<b>ALARMS</b>	SEWER / PUBLIC UTILITY ALARM	Sewer Plant, High Level, Pumping Station or other alarm related to a public utility.
<b>ALS</b>	ADVANCED LIFE SUPPORT CALL	Advanced Life Support Call
<b>ANIMAL</b>	ANIMAL COMPLAINT	Found / Lost Domestic, Farm, or Wild Animal.
<b>ARREST</b>	ARREST	Arrest made; prisoner in custody, not relating to any call already in progress.
<b>ASSALT</b>	ASSAULT **	The Unwanted verbal or physical contact on a person by a known or unknown actor.
<b>ASSIST</b>	ASSISTANCE CALL	Request by an agency, in or out of County, to have an officer assist their department when an incident has not previously been generated.
<b>ATL</b>	ATTEMPT TO LOCATE / BOLO	Attempt to Locate request; a BOLO (Be On The Lookout) request.
<b>BLS</b>	BASIC LIFE SUPPORT CALL	Basic Life Support Call
<b>BOMB</b>	BOMB THREAT \ ATTEMPT \ FOUND	Found Explosive device or ordinance. A threat or an attempt to use an explosive device or other ordinance.
<b>BREAKW</b>	WATER MAIN / LINE BREAK *	A natural or manmade break in a water main or line.
<b>BREAKS</b>	SANITARY SEWER MAIN / LINE BREAK *	A natural or manmade break in a sewer main or line.

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<b>BURG</b>	BURGLARY REPORT	Report of: Illegal entry into a Business or Residence, and the commission of a crime while inside.
<b>BURGA</b>	BURGLARY ALARM	Commercial or Residential Burglary / Glass-Break or Intrusion Alarm.
<b>BURGP</b>	BURGLARY IN PROGRESS **	Occurring of Just Occurred: Illegal entry into a Business or Residence, and the commission of a crime while inside.
<b>BURN</b>	CONTROL BURN / BURN COMPLAINT	Information received pertaining to a controlled burn, or complaint of a controlled burn.
<b>CHILD</b>	CHILD CUSTODY	Child custody issue or custody exchange.
<b>CIVIL</b>	CIVIL SERVICE	Service of Civil paperwork; Eviction Notices, Subpeonas, etc.
<b>CM</b>	CRIMINAL MISCHIEF REPORT	Report of any malicious act of destroying or damaging public or private property; just discovered or delayed report.
<b>CMP</b>	CRIMINAL MISCHIEF IN PROGRESS	Occurring of Just Occurred: Any malicious act of destroying or damaging public or private property.
<b>CO</b>	CARBON MONOXIDE (NO SYMPTOMS)	Any report of Carbon Monoxide whether reported via Alarm or Person, where there is no one reported to be having symptoms consistent with Carbon Monoxide poisoning.
<b>COWS</b>	CARBON MONOXIDE - WITH SYMPTOMS *	A Carbon Monoxide Alarm or a report of Carbon Monoxide in a building with person(s) reporting symptoms.
<b>COR</b>	CORONER REQUEST	Request for the Coroner's office to be contacted not related to any call already in progress.
<b>CRIMHX</b>	CRIMINAL HISTORY REQUEST	Documentation of a request to provide a Criminal History.

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<b>CRISIS</b>	CRISIS / MH EMERGENCY SERVICES	Request for the County Crisis / MHMR agency to be contacted not related to any call already in progress.
<b>DISTUR</b>	DISTURBANCE **	Verbal or Physical disturbance; civil disorder or disobedience.
<b>DIVERT</b>	HOSPITAL DIVERT STATUS	Report received from an In-County Hospital to place their facility on Divert because they are not accepting patients.
<b>DOM</b>	DOMESTIC REPORT **	Report of Domestic violence; verbal, physical or both; delayed report.
<b>DOMP</b>	DOMESTIC IN PROGRESS **	Occurring act of Domestic Violence which may be verbal, physical or both.
<b>DRUG</b>	DRUG INVESTIGATION / COMPLAINT	Occurring, Just Occurred, or Delayed; Drug Investigation or Complaint.
<b>DUMP</b>	DUMPING / GARBAGE COMPLAINT *	Occurring, Just Occurred, or Delayed: Complaint of Illegal Dumping.
<b>EID</b>	EMERGENCY ID ACTIVATION	Documentation relative to the activation of a Panic ID by Police, EMS, or Fire.
<b>EMNET</b>	EMNET TEST OR MESSAGE SENT	Actual or Test Message created thru State System relating to Emergency Broadcast
<b>ENTRY</b>	NCIC / CLEAN ENTRY	Entry of an Item / Person into CLEAN/NCIC.
<b>ESCORT</b>	ESCORT	Funeral, Treasury, Bank, Parade, Prisoner Transport, Etc.
<b>FIGHT</b>	FIGHT **	Two or more individuals involved in a physical confrontation.

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<b>FIRE</b>	FIRE GENERIC (TYPE) *	Unknown type Fire to be recoded on updated information.
<b>FIREA</b>	FIRE ALARM	Automatic Fire Alarm, Smoke Detector, or Water Flow Alarm activation either reported by a Monitoring Company or by a person.
<b>FIREB</b>	BRUSH FIRE *	Fire burning in vegetation that is predominantly shrubs, brush an scrub growth and an uncontrolled fire in a wooded area.
<b>FIREC</b>	COMMERCIAL STRUCTURE FIRE *	Offices, Small Retail Stores, Resturants, Multiple-Occupancy (Shopping Centers), Wholesale Houses, Storage Warehouse, Gas Stations.
<b>FIRE D</b>	DWELLING FIRE *	Single-Family Homes, Multi-Family Homes, Apartments (Less than 5 Units), manufactured homes.
<b>FIREHO</b>	HIGH OCCUPANCY FACILITY FIRE *	Hospitals, Schools, Churches, Apartment Buildings (More than 4 Units), Adult and Child Care Facilities, Hotels, Motels, Dormiries and any other places of assembly.
<b>FIREI</b>	INDUSTRIAL STRUCTURE FIRE *	Textile, Fabric, Metal, Wood or Chemical Works, Food Products, Flammable Liquids and Gases, Lumber Yards, Railroad Property, Bulk Oil/Gas Storage, Public Garage, Electrical Generating Plants, Landfills, Sewer / Water Works Facilities.
<b>FIRER</b>	RUBBISH / TRASH FIRE *	A fire of waste material including, but not limited to, garbage, waste paper, and debris form construction or demolition - Dumpster Fires.
<b>FIRES</b>	STRUCTURE FIRE *	Detached Garages, Sheds, Barns, Accessory Structure and any structure that does not fit any of the following classifications: FIREC, FIRE D, FIREHO, FIREI
<b>FIREV</b>	VEHICLE FIRE *	Car, Trucks, ATV, Boat, Motor Homes, Travel Trailers, Camping Trailers, Large Trucks, Trailers, and any other Vehicle.
<b>FIREW</b>	FIRE TRANSFORMER / WIRES *	Electrical Wires, Phone Wires, Cable, Fiber, Pole to included facilities attached or not attached to a pole, I.e. - Substations or Ground Facilities (Does not include facility inside of any structure).
<b>FLOOD</b>	FLOODING CONDITION	Any report of flooding conditions, whether it's on a roadway, outside the banks of a natural waterway, or rapidly increasing in depth inside of a structure.

<b>FOLLOW</b>	FOLLOW UP	Follow up to a previous investigation / complaint.
<b>FOUND</b>	FOUND PROPERTY	Report of found property.
<b>GAME</b>	GAME LAW COMPLAINT	Complaint of a game law violation where no other specific violations have occurred.
<b>GAS</b>	NG / LPG LEAK / ALARM OUTDOOR *	Any report of an odor, release, or leak of Natural Gas (NG) and/or Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG) whether reported via Alarm or Person and <b>Outdoors Only</b> that is not caused by physical contact.
<b>GASI</b>	NG / LPG LEAK / ALARM INDOOR *	Any report of an odor, release, or leak of Natural Gas (NG) and/or Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG) whether reported via Alarm or Person and <b>inside a structure</b> that is not caused by physical contact.
<b>GASO</b>	GAS OTHER LEAK / ALARM OUTDOOR *	Any report of a release or leak of a hazardous gas or unknown type of gas whether reported via Alarm or Person and <b>Outdoors Only</b> that is not caused by physical contact. I.E. - CO2, Ammonia, Chlorine Leak or alarms.
<b>GASOI</b>	GAS OTHER LEAK / ALARM INDOOR *	Any report of a release or leak of a hazardous gas or unknown type of gas whether reported via Alarm or Person and <b>inside a structure</b> that is not caused by physical contact. I.E. - CO2, Ammonia, Chlorine Leak or alarms.
<b>GENCOM</b>	GENERAL COMPLAINT REPORT	General complaint not otherwise able to be specifically classified.
<b>HARASS</b>	HARASSMENT	An individual who, with the intent to harass, annoy or alarm another person subjects another to physical contact, or attempts / threatens to do the same.
<b>INFO</b>	GENERAL INFORMATION	Information not able to be otherwise specifically classified.
<b>KNOX</b>	KNOX BOX RELEASE	Any request of a Knox Box Release by a unit who is not already assigned to another incident.
<b>LOCK</b>	LOCK OUT VEHICLE / BUILDING	Residential, Commercial, or Vehicular Lock-Out.

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<b>LOST</b>	LOST PROPERTY REPORT	Report of Lost Property.
<b>LZ</b>	SETUP AIRCRAFT LANDING ZONE	Request to setup an Aircraft Landing Zone, Medical, Police, Military or Civilian.
<b>MOVEUP</b>	MOVE UP ASSIGNMENT (FIRE & EMS)	Request for an agency to move into another provider;s station or coverage area in order to provide response coverage while the primary agency is committed.
<b>MP</b>	MISSING PERSON / RUNAWAY	Request to file a Missing Persons / Runaway Report.
<b>MVA</b>	MVA NON INJURY *	Motor Vehicle Accident - Non-Injury
<b>MVAE</b>	MVA EMS REQUEST	Any MVA when Police request EMS only for a BLS Patient for Evaluation or Sign-Off
<b>MVAI</b>	MVA WITH INJURIES *	Any Motor Vehicle Accident with Injuuries, Vehicle vs. Vehicle, Structure, or Person.
<b>MVAR</b>	MVA WITH ENTRAPMENT *	Any Motor Vehicle Accident with or without injuries, Vehicle vs. Vehicle, Structure, or Person with Entrapment.
<b>MVARUN</b>	HIT & RUN MVA NONE INJURY *	Any Motor Vehicle Accident - Non-Injury involving a Hit and Run.
<b>MVAU</b>	MVA UNKNOWN INJURIES *	Any Motor Vehicle Accident reported where the complainant(s) cannot confirm if there are any injuries, including Motor Vehicle vs. Vehicle, Structure, or Person.
<b>NOISE</b>	NOISE COMPLAINT	Complaint of Noise, Loud Music, Vehicle Alarm, Etc.
<b>ODOR</b>	ODOR/OTHER THAN SMOKE OUTDOOR *	Any report of an unknown odor reported outdoors other than Smoke, excluding Natural Gas (NG) and/or Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG)

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<b>ODORI</b>	ODOR/OTHER THAN SMOKE INDOOR *	Any report of an unknown Odor in a structure other than Smoke, excluding Natrual Gas (NG) and/or Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG).
<b>OOS</b>	STATION OUT OF SERVICE	Documentation to identify a station(s) Out Of Service.
<b>OPEN</b>	OPEN DOOR / WINDOW	Presence of an Open Door or Window, either residential or commercial.
<b>PARK</b>	PARKING COMPLAINT	Parking Complaint
<b>PC</b>	PHONE CALL	Caller requesting a Phone Call from an Agency or Officer.
<b>PFA</b>	PFA SERVICE	PFA Service; Weapons Confiscation; Eviction; Relative to the serving of a Protection from Abuse Order. [PFA Violations shall be classified otherwise as Domestic (DOM)]
<b>PUMP</b>	PUMP DETAIL	Any request for a Pump Detail due to water inside a Residence, Business or other Structure.
<b>PUR</b>	FOOT / VEHICLE PURSUIT **	Foot or Vehicle Pursuit
<b>RAPE</b>	RAPE REPORT **	Report: A person commits a felony of the first degree when he or she engages in sexual intercourse with a complaint: (1) By Forcible Compulsion or (2) By Threat of Forcible Compulsion that would prevent Resistance by a Person or Reasonable Resolution.
<b>RAPEP</b>	RAPE IN PROGRESSS **	Occurring or Just Occurred: Report of a Rape.
<b>RECK</b>	RECKLESS DRIVER	Occurring or Just Occurred, or Delayed: Report of a Reckless Driver.
<b>REPO</b>	REPOSSESSION	Information of Vehicle Repossession.



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<b>RES</b>	RESCUE (TYPE) *	Any Rescue not defined more clearly in any other specified type of Rescue Incident.
<b>RESCS</b>	CONFINE SPACE RESCUE *	Any Rescue due to a Building / Structure Collapse, Trench Rescue, Etc.
<b>RESE</b>	ELEVATOR RESCUE	Any Rescue from an Elevator due to malfunction or an elevator wherein persons are entrapped.
<b>RESIF</b>	INDUSTRIAL / FARM RESCUE *	Any Rescue from Machinery, whether it be Farm Equipment, Construction Equipment, or Manufacturing Equipment. (Note: If a person is not trapped in, or no longer trapped in said equipment and there are injuries reported, call should be coded as ALS or BLS)
<b>REST</b>	TERRAIN / SEARCH RESCUE	Any Rescue of a nature that would involve High-Angle, or Terrain Rescue, or any Rescue of person(s) attempting to be located in Wildlife / Nature Setting.
<b>RESW</b>	WATER / DIVE RESCUE	Any Rescue from Water (Lakes, Rivers, Ponds, Pools, Quarries, Etc), whether it be due to Vehicle into Water, Divers, Swimmers, Overturned Boats, Etc.
<b>ROAD</b>	ROAD HAZARD	Road Hazard condition not specifically categorized.
<b>ROB</b>	ROBBERY REPORT **	Report Only: The unlawful taking of property by force or threat of force.
<b>ROBP</b>	ROBBERY/HOLD UP IN PROGRESS **	Occurring or Just Occurred: The unlawful taking of property by force or threat of force.
<b>SA</b>	SPECIAL ASSIGNMENT	Special Assignment; School Post, Stand-By at an Athletic Event, DUI Checkpoints, Business Security Check, Foot Patrol, Etc.
<b>SEXOFF</b>	SEX OFFENSES **	Report of an offense with regard to a sexual nature other than Rape.
<b>SHOTS</b>	SHOTS FIRED	Reports of Shots Fired.

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<b>SIS</b>	STATION IN SERVICE	Documentation to identify a station(s) Placed In Service.
<b>SMOKE</b>	OUTDOOR SMOKE INVESTIGATION	Any report of Smoke, visible or odor, outdoors only. (Note: Any report of Smoke, visible or odor, indoors, should be coded as a FIRE consistent with what type of Structure is reported to in.)
<b>SPILL</b>	SPILL (Liquid / Solid) *	A "Spill" or exposure of any material(s) (Gas, Liquid or Solid) of any quantity which pose a hazard or potential hazard to the environment, or create a [Potential] Biological risk or hazard; any Hazardous Materials Incident, I.E. - Gasoline, Mercury, Magnesium.
<b>STAFF</b>	STAFFING ISSUE	Documentation of a Staffing related call for 911 Center Personnel.
<b>STR</b>	STRIKE TEAM RESPONSE	Request for Tender Task Force Strike Team - Out of County.
<b>STRIKE</b>	Gas Strike *	A report of any physical contact with a pipe, line, valve, ports, and/or meter that causes the release of a hazardous or unknown type of gas above or below grade.
<b>SUSACT</b>	SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY **	Reported Suspicious Activity, either Person or Vehicle.
<b>TDD</b>	TDD TEST CALL	Documenation to reflect the completion of a TDD Test Call
<b>TEST</b>	TEST (DO NOT DISPATCH)	Generic Test Call - Not specific to any other Test Call listed.
<b>TESTI</b>	ID/EID TEST	Documentation to reflect results of a Test Call completed for ID or EID
<b>TESTK</b>	KNOX TEST	Documentation to reflect results of a Test Call completed for Knox Box Release
<b>TESTR</b>	RADIO TEST	Documentation to reflect results of a Test Call completed for a Radio Test.

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<b>TESTT</b>	TONE(S) TEST	Documentation to reflect results of a Test Call completed for a Tone Test.
<b>THEFT</b>	THEFT REPORT	A person is guilty of theft if he unlawfully takes, or exercises unlawful control over, property of another with intent to deprive him thereof. I.E. - Drive-Off, Shoplifting.
<b>THEFTP</b>	THEFT IN PROGRESS **	Occurring or Just Occurred: The unlawful taking of property. If weapons or force is used, the incident should be coded as ROBP.
<b>THREAT</b>	TERRORISTIC THREATS	A person communicates, either directly or indirectly, a threat to commit any crime of violence with intent to terrorize another.
<b>TRAFF</b>	TRAFFIC CONTROL	Traffic Control for reasons other than a specified incident.
<b>TREE</b>	TREE DOWN	Any report of a tree down where it does not involve downed wires.
<b>TS</b>	TRAFFIC STOP	Vehicle Traffic Stop
<b>UGUEST</b>	UNWANTED GUEST **	Request by a caller to have an individual removed from their property; trespassing.
<b>UIS</b>	UNIT IN SERVICE	Documentation to identify a Unit Placed In Service.
<b>UOS</b>	UNIT OUT OF SERVICE	Documentation to identify a Unit Placed Out Of Service.
<b>VAC</b>	VACATION VIGILANCE REQUEST	Documentation to identify a request for Police to monitor Business or Residence while occupants are on vacation.
<b>VEHA</b>	ABANDONED VEHICLE	Report of an Abandoned Vehicle

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<b>VEHD</b>	DISABLED VEHICLE	Report of a vehicle, either in or out of traffic which is inoperable.
<b>VEHS</b>	STOLEN VEHICLE **	Occurring or Just Occurred, or Delayed: Stolen Vehicle Report
<b>WANT</b>	WARRANT SERVICE	Information / Location relative to the execution of a Search or Arrest Warrant.
<b>WELFAR</b>	WELFARE CHECK	Request to check the Welfare of an Individual(s).
<b>WIRE</b>	WIRE (GENERAL PROBLEM) *	Any report of a problem with a wire, electrical, cable, phone, etc. wherein the wire is not downed or reported to be arcing, sparking, or on fire.
<b>WIRED</b>	WIRES DOWN *	Any report of a downed wire, electrical, cable, phone, etc. wherein it has been detached from one source or another, and is not reported to be arcing, sparking, or on fire.
