



G-271 Hazardous Weather and Flooding Preparedness 2022 Course Offerings

The Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency (PEMA) is providing members of the Commonwealth the opportunity to take the G-271 Hazardous Weather and Flooding Preparedness course which will be held throughout the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. We have worked with the National Weather Service (NWS) Offices to secure the following dates and locations for 2022. These will be the only G-271 opportunities during the year scheduled by PEMA and the NWS.

G-271 Target Audience: The target audience for the course will encompass primarily the following professional groups: local emergency managers (i.e., county, city, township, or other jurisdiction), state emergency management personnel, voluntary agency representatives, and private sector emergency managers. G-271 is a required course for those wishing to obtain the PEMA County Advanced Certification designation.
