## What Goes in Your Pet Emergency Kit:




bowls, manual can opener

## GET A RESCUE ALERT STICKER.



These stickers are placed on a front-facing window, and will alert rescue workers

# **PUT TOGETHER AN EMERGENCY**

This should include: \* switched out every 2 months

## HAVE A LIST OF PET FRIENDLY HOTELS AND SHELTERS

will not allow pets. Have a list of pet-friendly hotels along your evacuation route, or the contact information for a pet shelter you can drop your pet off at.



## KEEP IDENTIFICATION ON YOUR PET AND AN EXTRA COPY IN THE MERGENCY SUPPLY KIT.



Micro Micro chipping your pet is extremely beneficial to reuniting you with them in the event you are separated.

Place veterinarian, kennel, vaccination records, etc in waterproof bags.

case you can't get home due emergency or illness, make sure your pets are taken care of. Cut out the card below and carry it in your wallet, purse, backpack, or leave it in your car to inform first responders or others pets at home that need cared for.
