- 2022-2023 HMRF Grant was finalized & closed out on 8/7/2023.
- Bullex Simulator at fire school
  - Per MRa, he was asked to advise those in attendance that the simulator may have been damaged during the flood event at the Northampton County Fire School that occurred on July 15-16, 2023. Vendor advised staff to let the unit dry and then test it. Per MRa, unit may have to go for repairs if it is damaged, unknown cost at this time.
    - JB inquired if there was insurance on the equipment or property that would cover the cost of repairs? MRa was unsure and would check on that.
- Lithium Ion Battery class/training
  - MRa stated that he is trying to obtain and schedule a training in the near future.

#### XIV. Good of the Order

- JB advised those in attendance that he had attended a demonstration of the Rosenbauer Battery Extinguishing System held in Lebanon County not too long ago. JB stated that the demonstration was for a tool that pierces the battery to assist with extinguishing any fire. JB advised that the area shall possibly consider purchasing one of these systems and make it available county wide, due to cost, for use if or when needed. Per JB the Rosenbauer tool is approximately \$30,000 to purchase.
  - KK & KT provided feedback on their thoughts and concerns when dealing with extinguishing a lithium ion battery type fires.
  - KK recommended that we put any tool purchase funds towards providing training since that itself is desperately needed locally. Plus these extinguishment tools continue to evolve and would not want money wasted or spent on tool(s) that may not be the best approach if guidance is ever presented on proper or best extinguishment techniques.
- KT proposed the LEPC funding the "Emergency Response Decision Support System (ERDSS)" aka Chemical Companion in-person training course. Per KT this course will cost approximately six thousand dollars (\$6,000) however, the program and training is robust and extremely useful during hazardous materials responses. KT would like this to be presented and brought for a vote at the next LEPC meeting in December, 2023.
  - Note: After discussion it was noted that NCEM Director Todd Weaver is attempting to have this course financed via funds from the Northeast PA Counter Terrorism funding. Hope to have decision on this prior to the next quarterly LEPC meeting in December.
- JE (*Air Liquide representative*) had inquired if his cohorts (*hazardous materials response members*) within Air Liquide would be eligible to partake in any of the local trainings. Advised JE that I would get clarification and respond back to him.
