
How to make a Home Fire Escape Plan

Draw a map of your home. Show ALL doors & windows.
Visit each room. Find 2 ways out.
All windows & doors should open easily. You should be able to use them to get outside.
Make sure your home has smoke alarms. Push the test button to make sure each alarm is working.
Pick a meeting place outside. It should be in front of your home. Everyone will meet at that meeting place
Make sure your house or building number can be seen from the street.
Talk about your plan with everyone in your home.
Educated everyone on calling 911 if there is a fire in your home.
Practice your home fire drill!
Make your own home fire escape plan using the grid provided on page 2 (turn over) or any other paper.



- Draw a floor plan or a map of your home. Show **ALL doors** & **windows**.
- Mark two ways out of each room
- Mark all of the smoke alarms with SA
 - o Smoke alarms should be in inside & outside of each sleeping area & on each level of your home!
- Pick a family **meeting place** outside where everyone can meet.
- Remember, practice your plan at least twice a year!
