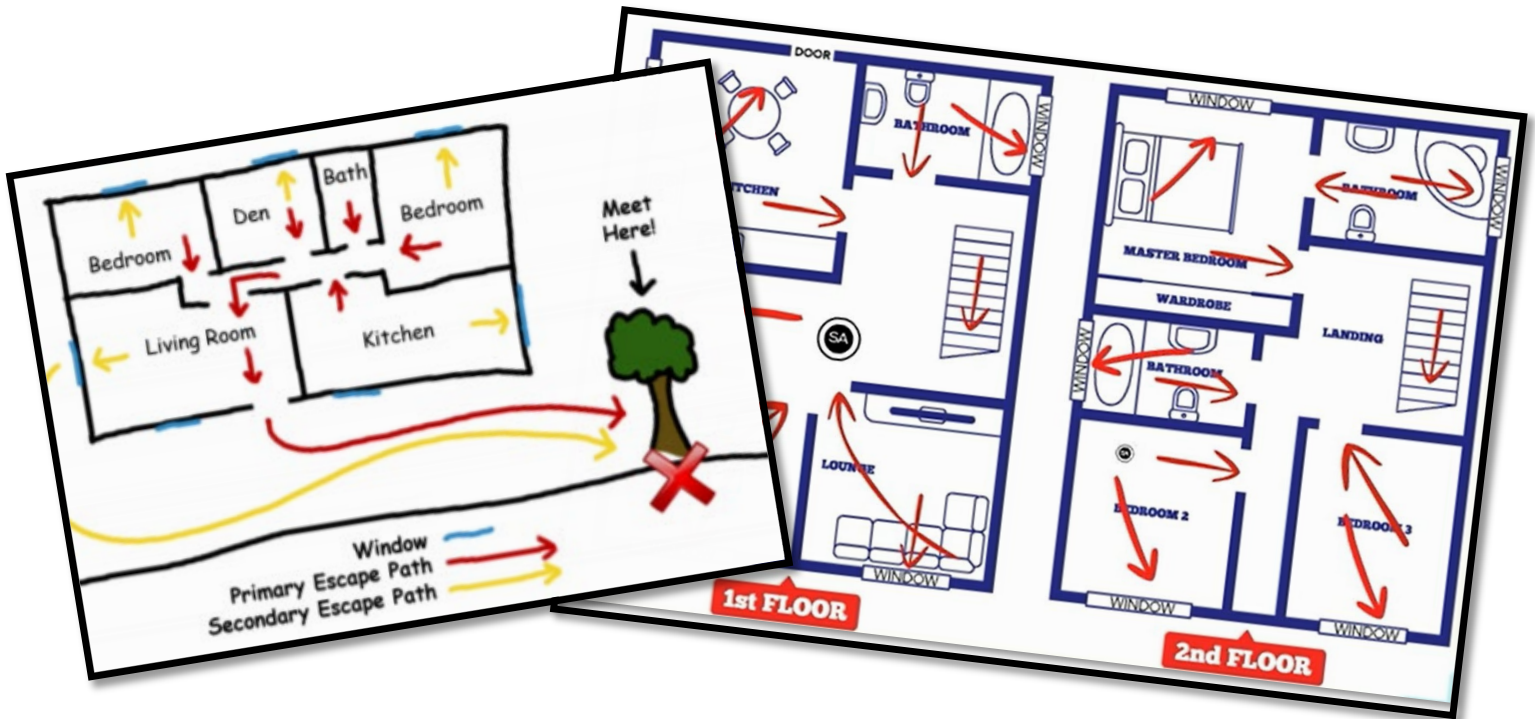





Home Fire Escape Plan

How to make a Home Fire Escape Plan

- Draw a map of your home. Show ALL doors & windows.
- Visit each room. Find 2 ways out.
- All windows & doors should open easily. You should be able to use them to get outside.
- Make sure your home has smoke alarms. Push the test button to make sure each alarm is working.
- Pick a meeting place outside. It should be in front of your home. Everyone will meet at that meeting place.
- Make sure your house or building number can be seen from the street.
- Talk about your plan with everyone in your home.
- Educated everyone on calling 911 if there is a fire in your home.
- Practice your home fire drill!
- Make your own home fire escape plan using the grid provided on page 2 (turn over) or any other paper.



- Draw a floor plan or a map of your home. Show **ALL doors & windows**.
- Mark **two ways out** of each room
- Mark all of the **smoke alarms** with **SA**
 - Smoke alarms should be in inside & outside of each sleeping area & on each level of your home!
- Pick a family **meeting place** outside where everyone can meet.
- Remember, **practice** your plan at least **twice a year!**
