- Drager X-site updates
 - MR shared with the attendees that our agency has possession of 4 Drager x-site air monitors. Advised those in attendance that we have utilized these during emergency responses, training events and planned events such as Musikfest. Two of the meters in our possession are older models and need updating. Per MR he is asking the LEPC group for funds to ship back the 2 older Drager, get them updated and returned back to us. Per MR the estimated cost he received in June, 2025 from the manufacturer was approx. \$485.00 PER unit to update. Unsure if costs have increased since.
 - MRi asked the group if there was a motion to approve the spending necessary to update 2 of the Drager x-site meters. KT made a motion to allow spending UP TO \$1,200 to get both Drager x-site meters updated. Motion 2nd by JB, all in favor.
